- Official name: the Republic of Moldova
- Area: 33,8 thousand km²
- Population: 2,5 million inhabitants
- Official language: Romanian
- Capital city: Chisinau
- Independence Day: 27 August 1991
- Officially recognized: 02 March 1992



- Moldova is a country in Eastern Europe bordering with Romania and Ukraine with a rich tourist potential and this small piece of land fully deserves to be named a "Corner of Heaven"
- Situated at the intersection of the principal commercial roads of Eurasia, the Republic of Moldova represents a genuine hub which brings together the experience, continuity and diversity of generations that have shaped the present and influence the future.
- Moldova is proud of picturesque landscapes, historical places and fortresses, wine brands and wine cellars, churches and monasteries, and the last but not the least of its people whose hospitality is famous all around the world.
- Moldova is one of the most important winegrowing states in the world, the number of local wineries is estimated at around 200.
- Moldova is famous for unique underground cities such as Cricova and Milestii Mici. While Cricova represents the largest underground complex known all around the world for its immense labyrinths with the 120 kilometers of overall galleries' length, Milestii Mici boasts of the biggest wine collection in the world which consists of more than 1,5 million wine bottles which entered the Guinness Book of Records in 2005.

Chisinau International Airport in figures and dates:

- ✓ 40 destinations in Europe, Asia, Middle East and Africa
- ✓ 2 home-based passenger airlines: Flyone, Hisky
- ✓ 1 home-based cargo airlines: Aerotranscargo
- ✓ 19 foreign passenger airlines: Aegean Airlines, Air Baltic, Air Montenegro, Arkia, Austrian Airlines, Azerbaijan Airlines, EL AL, Euro Wings, Flyone Armenia, Freebird Airlines, Georgian Wings, Hisky Europe, Israil, LOT Polish Airlines, Pegasus Airlines, Tailwind Airlines, Tarom, Turkish Airlines, Wizz Air
- ✓ The runway 08-26 is 3590 meters long and 45 meters wide, type of surface – cement concrete. Constructed in 1987 and completely reconstructed in 2023, and is still one of the longest runways in the Eastern Europe.
- ✓ The runway 09-27 is 2383 meters long and 45 meters wide, type of surface – cement concrete. Was put into operation in 2018.
- ✓ Airfield code is 4D, airfield functions 24/7
- ✓ Overall area of the airfield is 364 hectares
- ✓ 31 May 1995: certified as an International Airport



- Chisinau International Airport meets all international safety and security standards.
- The main priorities of the activity of the “Chisinau International Airport” is providing the highest standards of the aviation security and quality of the provided services.
- Chisinau International Airport is a member of Airport Council International (ACI) Europe and of Romanian Airport Association (AAR).
- Three-letter IATA code of Chisinau International Airport has been recently changed from KIV to RMO.
- Convenient geographical position and excellent infrastructure of the airport are a perfect starting point for any type of a trip, be it a leisure or business travel.
