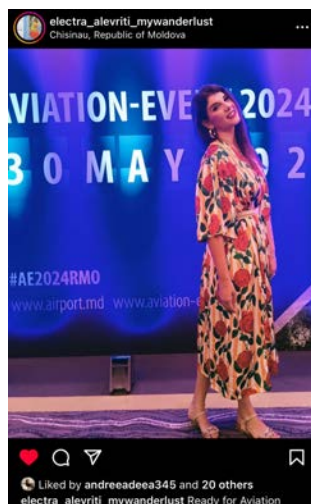

Salzburg Airport - W. A. Mozart: Interview with CEO Bettina Ganghofer "The building it reached the end of its life"
A few weeks ago, the Aviation-Event aviation congress organized from Marcel Riwaltsky took place in Chisinau, Moldova, attended by numerous top managers from the aviation business. I took the opportunity to interview the Managing Director of Salzburg Airport - W. A. Mozart for an aéroTELEGRAPH story...
Following the general refurbishment of Salzburg Airport's runway in 2019, a new mega-project is on the agenda with the construction of a new airport terminal. I spoke to Bettina Ganghofer about various topics, such as the current offer: "Ganghofer believes that Salzburg is well positioned with its range of airlines and destinations. Unfortunately, the business segment is not as well positioned as it was before the crisis. This reflects the German market with its stagnating demand."
About the new top dog Eurowings/Eurowings Europe and the resumption of Wizz Air flights: Lufthansa Group subsidiary Eurowings, with its three Airbus A321XLR jet stationed in Salzburg, has become the new home provider following the cancellation of Austrian Airlines "Passengers from Lufthansa and Eurowings together now account for half of our total passenger volume," says Ganghofer.
Other low-cost airlines are also providing a new boost

Wizz Air President: Robert Carey
"Could fly the Airbus Aircraft A321 XLR from Abu Dhabi to Singapore"
He is an old hand in the aviation industry, Robert Carey can already look back on twenty years of experience in the aviation industry, working for Delta Air Lines, easyJet and now for exactly four years as President of the up-and-coming Wizz Air.
At the Aviation-Event in Chisinau, organised by Marcel Riwaltsky, the Chisinau International Airport and the government of Moldova in May, I had the opportunity to interview Wizz Air President Robert Carey about possible destinations for the Airbus Aircraft A321 XLR, lack of growth and the airline's aircraft in Ukraine.
In our interview for the industry magazine aéroTELEGRAPH, we spoke about the company's current challenges: "This year could be very different to previous years, as we are not planning any further growth due to the known problems with the Pratt & Whitney engines. Around 50 aircraft are currently parked due to the checks, which is why we have to be super efficient again this year in order to maintain our flight programme."
"Where the first A321XLRs could be deployed: "We have large bases in the west, such as London, Rome, Milan and Flughafen Wien - Vienna Airport. But on the other hand, we also have our markets in the east. We could open up many new markets, for example in North
